- ❖ How did you and your fiancé(e)/husband/wife meet?
- ❖ Any unique qualities about your wedding?
- ❖ How did you find out about VegNews and this feature?
- ❖ Are you a VegNews subscriber?
- ❖ Provide the full names of the couple (pre-wedding) as well as contact information (mailing address, email, and phone)
- ❖ Attach a digital photo to help us better visualize your wedding. If your wedding hasn't happened, attach a photo of you and your fiancé(e)
- ❖ Include credit-card details for a \$25 non-refundable processing fee

Selected couples will be notified by January 1. At that time, we will request more detailed information and photos.
